Mainstage productions focus on excellence in family theatre, developing a broad base appreciation for live theatre and promoting positive values through art. A Mainstage season of 4 musicals and 1 play are produced from September to August at two venues in Issaquah and Everett, Washington. Attendance was 129,332 patrons at 360 performances.

Village Originals is a mission driven program to commission and produce new musicals that achieve national exposure. Through the Village Originals program, new works are produced to various degrees in collaboration with the show's creators. This process helps to foster the growth of new musicals in America and around the world. 1,810 people attended Village Originals programming throughout the year which included the Festival of New Musicals. The Festival, held in Issaquah, features readings and discussion of 6 new musicals over 3 days. Village Theatre is one of only a handful of professional theatre companies throughout the country that commissions and develops new musicals and it's reputation is continuing to grow on a national level.

KIDSTAGE trains young people in theatre skills for career opportunities and enriched lives by offering classes and performance opportunities. KIDSTAGE education programs consist of year-round classes and performance opportunities in 2 locations: Issaquah and Everett, Washington. Enrollment in classes was 2,074 students. KIDSTAGE produced 12 musicals throughout the year between both locations. An audience of 10,496 attended 79 performances. Some of the performance opportunities are provided at no cost to the students; while others are tuition based.

They also authorize the Executive Producer to sign the return. The formal review is scheduled for the January finance committee meeting. Any board members who are not members of the finance committee who are interested in formally reviewing the return are invited to attend the January finance committee meeting. Prior to the January finance committee meeting management emails the completed return to all voting board members. Any feedback or comments are discussed and approved by the committee. The Treasurer leads the review process and the preparer, a licensed CPA, is on hand to answer questions. At the January executive committee meeting the finance committee recommends approval by the executive committee who is authorized to act on behalf of the full board. After approval by the executive committee, management electronically files the return with the IRS.

Form 990, Part VI, Section B, Line 12c - Annually the Board is given a copy of the conflict of interest policy and then asked to sign a certificate of acknowledgement that affirms that they have read and understood the policy and have agreed to comply with the articles of the policy. Additionally, the Board annually fills out a Board questionnaire that inquires about any family or business relationships that may be potential conflicts as well as inquiring about business transactions and compensation.

Form 990, Part VI, Section B, Line 15 - For the fiscal year ending 8/31/12, the executive committee of the Board of Directors of Village Theatre established an executive compensation and performance review committee. This committee meets twice a year with the Executive Producer and reviews goals and performance. The committee evaluates CEO salaries at comparable theatres in the National Alliance for Musical Theatre salary review and selected 990 tax returns for regional theatres in the Seattle area and around the country. The committee brings their compensation recommendation to the executive committee. The CEO compensation package is voted on by the full Board. Other key employees salaries are presented at the finance committee for review as part of the annual budgeting process which is approved by the full Board.

Significant activities are: Mainstage which produces 4 musicals and 1 nonmusical show each season that are geared toward the entire family; Village Originals - a nationally recognized program that develops new musicals; KIDSTAGE - an uniquely designed educational program that uses theatre to build critical life skills in each participant; and Pied Piper which brings the wonderful world of live theatre to children and their families in the greater Puget Sound area by hosting renowned theatre, dance, and music companies for public and school performances.
