SCRIPT CONTENT DETAILS:

Language

The phrases "ass", "crap", and "holy shit" are each used once. The phrases "bastard", "damn", and "oh my god" are each used twice.

Alcohol

There is a wedding and accompanying parties at which alcohol is served; a few characters appear hungover the morning after.

Sexual Content

In Donna's old diary, she references the summer of 1979 in which she dated three different men ("We kissed on the beach, and dot, dot, dot"). Sophie refers to her potential dad as "the sperm donor," Donna says "I'm going to be muscled out by an ejaculation." It is implied that a young bartender spent the night with Tanya, she sings "Does Your Mother Know". A couple kisses multiple times.
