SEASON HIGHLIGHTS

The 2017-2018 Season was another year of artistic success and growth for Village Theatre as we shared a Mainstage Season of five compelling shows with our Subscriber base of over 19,000 Subscribers as well as over 59,331 single ticket buyers between both Issaquah and Everett. It was the final year of artistic director Steve Tomkins' 25 year career with us, and his legacy was joyfully celebrated while teams prepared to welcome a new artistic leader to the helm.

The Season opened with *Into the Woods*, a Stephen Sondheim classic directed and choreographed by Kathryn Van Meter. Featuring a turntable set with ladders for tree trunks and leaves made up of paper wishes from the local community, this production was both moving and unique in its charm and artistry. The cast was full of beloved Village Theatre regulars like Eric Polani Jensen, Allison Standley, and Alexandria Henderson, as well as some newer faces like Kevin Vortmann, Arika Matoba, and Rafael Molina. The show was celebrated by press and audience members alike, who proclaimed it to be "outstanding," "delightful," and "one of my all-time favorites — and I have been going for about 15 years."

With the winter, audiences ventured to New York City with the Newsboys of 1899 as they organized a city-wide strike against journalism giant Joseph Pulitzer. Disney's *Newsies* hit the stage with a stellar cast of 17 dancing young men who executed Katy Tabb's Gregory Award-winning choreography with skill and energy – thrilling audiences for 84 performances! Christopher Mumaw's jungle-gym

set created a playpen for the cast to perform flips, jumps, swings, and more. In the role of Jack Kelly, we were thrilled to bring Joey Barreiro to our stage to reprise his role from the National Tour – but with that special Village Theatre flavor. He enjoyed building the character anew and working with director Steve Tomkins to keep the production fresh and unique. *The Seattle Times* raved that *Newsies* was "a lean, energetic, crowd-pleasing machine" and said "the show's physicality is ecstatic – and so are we."

As the non-musical play for the Season, *The Gin Game* came to the stage as a battle of wits and snappy dialogue. This production featured real-life married couple Kurt Beattie and Marianne Owen, both acting legends in the Seattle theatre scene. They were directed by fellow Seattle icon and friend, Jeff Steitzer. A masterful balance of heart-wrenching drama and farcical comedy, *The Gin Game* was full of humor, spirit, and more than a touch of warfare. *BroadwayWorld* proclaimed it to be "refreshing to see a production defy narrative expectations" and *Drama in the Hood* said "it's not

often we get an opportunity to laugh out loud and then face our demons."

The new musical for the year, *String*, was the first show to go through every stage of the Village Originals program, beginning as a reading at The Festival of New Musicals, then becoming a Beta Series developmental production, and finally landing with a Mainstage World Premiere. Authors Adam Gwon and Sarah Hammond came to Issaquah for the full rehearsal process to work with the cast and finalize the script, in coordination with director Brandon Ivie. The story featured three Greek goddesses who are banished by Zeus to a modern-day skyscraper and forced to work among mortals. Ultimately a story of love, sacrifice, and mortality, *String* took a charming new look at the imperfections that make us human. *The Daily Record* called it "enchanting entertainment" and *425 Magazine* said "whether you're a seasoned theatre-goer or just dipping your toe into the arts, *String* is one you'll want to watch."

Finally, the Season came to a close with a rousing and joyous production of *Hairspray*. It was Steve Tomkins' final directing project as artistic director, for which he was joined by co-director Timothy

McCuen Piggee. Featuring a cast of 27 and a 12-piece orchestra, *Hairspray* received an incredible nine Gregory Award nominations, including Outstanding Production, Ensemble, Director, and Choreography, and won best costume design and Supporting Actress. The reviews speak for themselves:

RESIDENCIES

In the 2017-2018 fiscal year, Village Theatre undertook three residencies in Issaquah, WA. This program is for scripts that are not yet completed, or even begun, and aims to give authors dedicated, focused time to develop further ideas, generate materials, and test drafts with professional actors, while receiving constant feedback and dramaturgical support. Residencies included *Teddy & Max* by Zoe Sarnak and Brian Crawley, and *The Homefront* by Jenny Stafford and Sam Salmond, both of which later appeared in The 18th Annual Festival of New Musicals. The third residency was for an untitled new project by Rhianna Atendido.

Village Theatre also supported five residencies in New York City as part of the new *At The Table* program, which strives to give amplification to voices currently left out of the mainstream musical theatre world. Residency projects for the year included *Bandits on the Run* by Adrian Enscoe, Sydney Shepherd, and Regina Strayhorn; *Untitled Agent 355* by Preston Max Allen and Jessica Kahkoska; *I Have A Dream* by Troy Anthony and Sukari Jones; *U.G.L.Y.* by Michael R. Jackson and Darius Smith; and *Next Step* by Melissa Li and Kit Yan.

THE FESTIVAL OF NEW MUSICALS

The 18th Annual Festival of New Musicals was held on August 10 – 12, 2018 at the Francis J. Gaudette Theatre, drawing performers, directors, writers, and composers from all over the country. Performances of the shows are simple on-book readings with a cast singing and reading through the full show for an audience of industry and Village Originals members. The authors get to hear their script performed (often for the first time), and make changes based on audience feedback and their own observations.

This year's Festival included readings of: *Elysium: An American Fable*, a powerful musical about an Ohio family crushed

under the weight of its own secrets; *The Passage*, a haunting story of a young boy as he confronts the monstrous illness facing his father; *Teddy & Max*, a folk-rock musical about a female singing duo in the 60s; *Hansel & Gretel & Heidi & Günter*, a fairytale sequel set in modern day Chicago; and *The Homefront*, a rock musical about female factory workers at the end of World War II. The event also featured the Northwest Songwriters Showcase, which included performances of eight different songs by musical theatre writers in the Pacific Northwest region.

BETA SERIES

The 2017–2018 Season marked the second Season of Village Theatre's Beta Series program, which offers a platform for writers to see their musical on stage, while continuing to make adjustments — even throughout the run. The shows are produced at First Stage Theatre in Issaquah,

and the production designs are intentionally kept simple, to allow the team to make changes without worrying about big set pieces or complicated mechanics. Audience feedback is key to the process and there are talkbacks following each performance, as well as surveys distributed in paper and online.

The Season opened with *How to Break*, a groundbreaking musical about two teenage hip hop dancers as they battle not only their disease, but also the hospital caregivers, for control over their own bodies. The following show, *Afterwords*, tells the story of three women bound by notes scribbled down on paper, and the art we make from the love that makes us. The Season closed with *ZM*, a hilarious musical by the creators of *Urinetown*, chronicling a fast-food induced zombie apocalypse.

YOUTH EDUCATION

BY THE NUMBERS

2017–2018 VILLAGE THEATRE'S YOUTH EDUCATION PROGRAMS

56,152 The total number of people reached by Village Theatre Youth Education Programs during the 2017–2018 Season.

42,113 Total youth who experienced Village Theatre and Youth Education programs including youth audiences. Up 10% over prior season.

26,928 Number of students in KIDSTAGE and Pied Piper programs. (This does not include KIDSTAGE or Mainstage youth audiences.)

Village Theatre's Youth Education and Community Outreach programs served over 56,000 young people, families, and educators throughout the Puget Sound. Available to all regardless of the ability to pay, the programs provide healthy out of school time activities, stimulate learning through the arts in schools, provide access to the arts for underserved populations, develop young artists, and promote skills for enriched and successful lives.

The 2017–2018 Season was very successful on every level. The KIDSTAGE program was selected for the new Youth Program Quality Initiative lab with a focus on Social Emotional Learning. KIDSTAGE continues to have among the highest scores in the country for quality. Our work on social equity and efforts to increase the accessibility of the program have really taken hold. Our programs are more culturally responsive and teaching artists are playing a large role. We believe all students benefit from a multi-cultural, safe, and inclusive environment. In addition to outreach, partnerships, and hiring more teaching artists and theatre professionals of color, we provided two racial equity workshops for our staff and teaching artists. Through these efforts we have made adjustments to policies and procedures that continue to reduce social and cultural barriers to access and are seeing the results of increased participation by low income students and students of color.

KIDSTAGE

KIDSTAGE is a youth development program that advances Skills for Theatre...Skills for Life through after-school classes, camps, productions and apprenticeships, as well as in-school workshops and residencies.

- 3,899 KIDSTAGE students worked directly with professional artists, designers, and arts educators to build social and theatrical skills and explored all facets of theatre and musical theatre. 33% received scholarships or free programs.
- KIDSTAGE continues work with the nationwide Youth Program Quality Initiative (YPQI).

The YPQI is both a professional development program and data driven assessment tool that helps ensure youth engagement and program quality. KIDSTAGE received among the highest scores in the country.

- Two elementary schools on the Eastside continued their partnership with KIDSTAGE to bring theatre arts into every classroom. These programs are in their sixth year.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

Pied Piper – Theatre for Young Audiences Series and Arts in Education Program brings literature to life in the classroom and onstage for schools and the public at very affordable prices.

- 18,911 students throughout East King, Snohomish, and Island Counties joined their class or family to attend a Pied Piper presentation in a theatre in Bellevue, Issaquah, or Everett.
- 5,551 students received free tickets or theatre workshops.
- Nearly 300 people attended a free Sensory Friendly performance thanks to funding from the Nysether Family Funds at the Community Foundation.

Free Performances for the Public

- Everett KIDSTAGE performed for 2,000 audience members this summer in the Wetmore Theatre Plaza with six free performances of *Seussical Kids*.
- SummerStock production of *Les Misérables* in Everett provided a Pay-What-You-Can performance for 398 people.
- 360 people attended one of two free KIDSTAGE performances during the City of Everett's popular Wintertide event.

FINANCIAL INFORMATION

During the 2017–2018 Season, Village Theatre produced five outstanding shows in its Mainstage season with a total of 386 performances. The Mainstage season saw attendance of 94,266 patrons in Issaquah and 56,324 in Everett. Coming off a record high year last season, the total number of Subscribers decreased this season by 5% bringing the cumulative total number of Subscribers to 19,033 which is similar to the 2015–2016 Season.

KIDSTAGE continued to expand and saw growth in revenue especially in its highly acclaimed Institute program. Continued focus was given to expanding scholarship and outreach programs. Attendance at the 10 KIDSTAGE productions throughout the year was over 17,000. The Pied Piper program presented six shows to school groups and families and saw overall attendance of over 21,000.


The Village Originals program, which continues to attract local as well as national attention from writers and directors across the country, produced another successful Festival of New Musicals in the summer and continued producing its Beta Series of three developmental productions at First Stage.

Total earned revenue from operations was similar to the prior year at \$9.9 million. Through the generous support of our patrons, foundations, corporate and government partners, contributions were close to \$3.4 million dollars which represents a significant increase from the prior year. Operating expenses increased 6.2% from the prior year mainly due to labor costs and inflation. Overall, due to the combined efforts of a supportive community and a creative and dedicated Village Theatre team, the organization ended the year with an operating surplus before depreciation (a noncash expenditure) of \$17,663. When combining operations and nonoperating activity, the overall change in net assets was a surplus of \$584,931.

Beginning in 2005, the theatre launched a capital campaign. The campaign proceeds were used to purchase land and build the new Technical Studios (which house the scene, prop and paint shops), reconstruct First Stage, convert an Everett City building into a theatre and education facility, and cover the cost of the campaign. The campaign goal as of August 31, 2018 is \$10 million. As of August 31, 2018, and 2017, \$9,790,510 and \$9,819,752 respectively, had been pledged or given towards that goal, net of write-offs. The Craig and Joan Watjen Technical Studios were completed in 2007 and reconstruction of First Stage was completed in March 2011. The Everett Youth Education Center (now called The Cope Gillette Theatre) was completed in September 2013.

The theatre has purchased property adjacent to the Technical Studios and is planning to build a storage warehouse for sets and props.

In 2016, the theatre began building an endowment as part of the Board's long-term strategic plan to grow an endowment to help provide future financial stability. The goal for this endowment is \$14 million. As of August 31, 2018, the endowment consists of donor-restricted and board designated funds established for Village Originals, Youth Education, and operations. The total value of the endowment fund as of August 31, 2018 was \$734,154 which includes: \$652,745 of permanently restricted net assets; \$69,147 of temporarily restricted accumulated unspent earnings; and \$12,262 of board designated funds.

ENDOWMENT

Over the past 39 years Village Theatre has grown to become a leader in musical theatre. In February of 2018 with the addition of a dedicated staff member (due to the support from a three-year grant from The Murdock Charitable Trust) Village Theatre began the quiet phase of an endowment fund campaign (a charitable investment account that generates a yearly income) to strengthen our creative capacity and nourish our programs. At the end of August 2018 we received over \$1.5 million in new gifts and commitments towards reaching our \$14 million endowment goal. Gifts of all sizes have been allocated to our General Endowment while gifts of over \$100,000 qualify for special naming recognition and purpose restrictions based on donor preference (shown below in blue). Funds are aggregated and professionally invested, serving as a perpetual source of income to sustain our programs for generations to come. To ensure proper stewardship of these resources, we've established an Investment Committee made up of board members who oversee investment transactions, and we've also adopted a company distribution policy which provides that up to 5% of the market value of the fund be paid out yearly to ensure the corpus remains in-tact in perpetuity.
