Mean Girls: High School Version is a hilarious, entertaining, and at times, brutally honest look into the lives of teens as they struggle to learn to love themselves and accept others while rejecting the toxicity of social media, jealousy, and gossip in high school.

While the show is a High School Version, it is unique in that it retains the original script from the full Broadway production; the only thing that makes it a High School Version are suggestions from the playwright about how to change potentially difficult lines and staging for younger actors.

As such, the script contains some profanity, bullying, an instance of sexual harassment, sexual content including flirting and references to teen sex, a depiction of teen drinking at a party, mentions of drug use, and offensive language about larger bodies and body image.

There is a comedic depiction of Regina getting hit by a bus.

The musical is based on the movie which has a Pg-13 rating. Some material in the production may not be appropriate for children of all ages.
